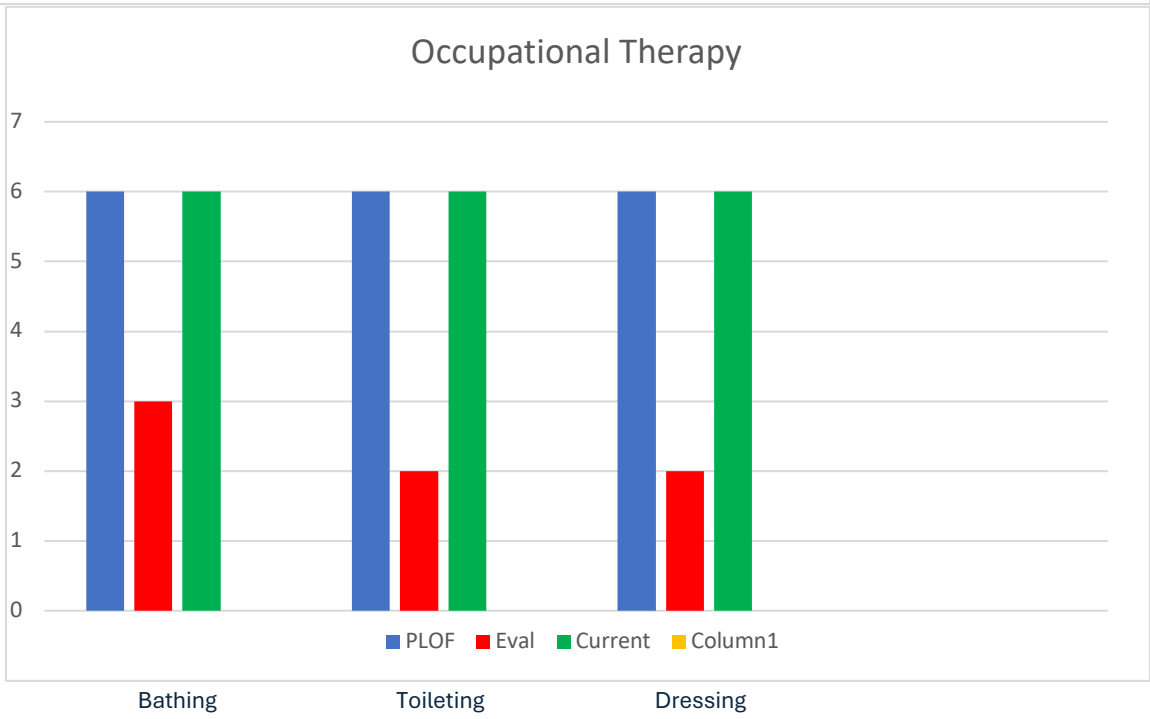
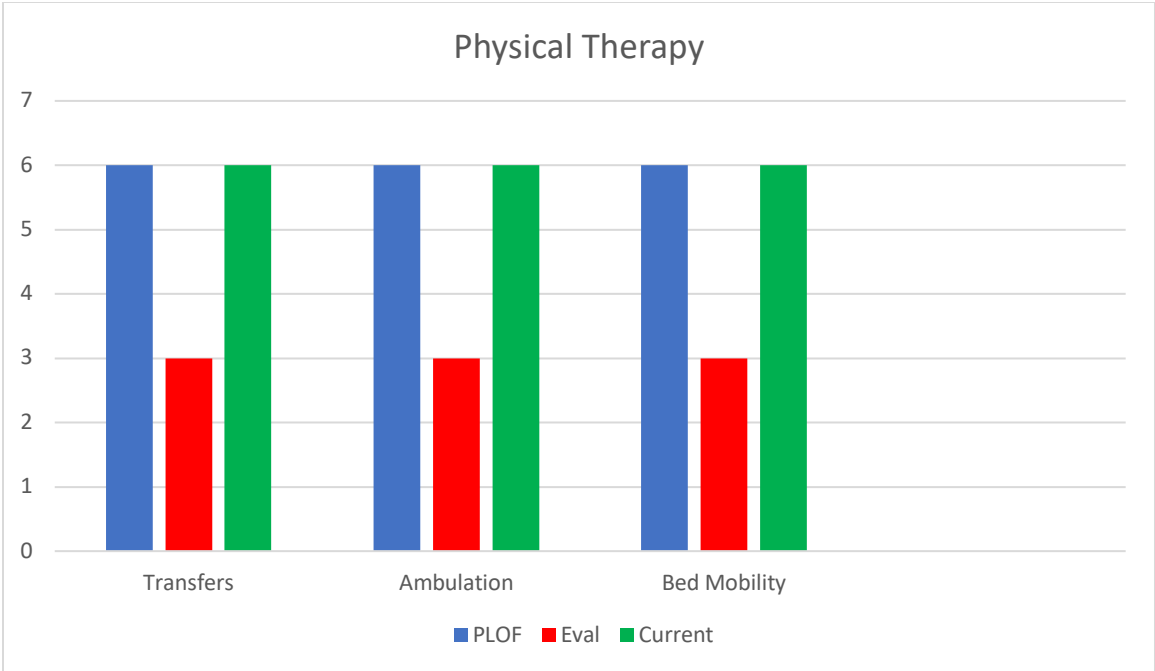


Mrs. Belinda Cavazos is a 75 year old female who admitted to Crowley Nursing and Rehab on 7/5/24 following a fall with subsequent right femur fracture and surgical repair. Prior to this injury, Mrs. Cavazos lived at home alone and was MODIFIED INDEPENDENT for ambulation of 200' feet and ADLs. At admission to this skilled nursing facility, Belinda was MOD-MAX ASSIST for ambulation of 5' feet and ADLs. The patient set goals for improving her functional level of independence to be able to discharge home alone.

Physical Therapy evaluated Mrs. Cavazos on 7/5/24. She required MODA for ambulation, bed mobility, and wheelchair mobility. At eval, Belinda reported 6/10 pain and had moderately impaired leg strength and balance. PT set goals for Mrs. Cavazos to improve her bed mobility, ambulation, wheelchair mobility, leg strength, balance, and reduce her pain.

Occupational Therapy evaluated Belinda on 7/7/24 where she required MAXA for toileting, lower body dressing, and bathing and needed MINA for grooming/hygiene. OT set goals for the patient to improve her ability to complete ADLs independently.

Mrs. Cavazos received 39 days of skilled nursing and rehab services where she made significant functional gains. Mrs. Cavazos can ambulate 125' using her 2WW and completes ADLs, dressing, bathing, toileting with MODIFIED INDEPEDENCE. Mrs. Cavazos met her personal goal of discharging back to her home with an improved functional level of independence.



MDS Section GG Functional Scores

06 Independent

Completes the activity by him/herself with no assistance from a helper

05- Setup or clean-up assistance

Helper sets up or cleans up; patient completes activity. Helper assists only prior to or following the activity.

04 - Supervision or touching assistance

Helper provides verbal cues and/or touching/steadying and/or contact guard

assistance as patient completes activity. Assistance may be provided throughout the activity or intermittently.

03 - Partial/moderate assistance

Helper does LESS THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts, holds, or supports trunk or limbs but provides less than half the effort.

02 - Substantial/maximal assistance

Helper does MORE THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts or holds trunk

or limbs and provides more than half the effort.

01 - Dependent

Helper does ALL the effort. Patient does none of the effort to

complete the activity. Or the assistance of 2 or more helpers is required for the patient to complete the activity.
